Truck Stories (Stage 1-9) is the core of the reading programme, all about the little boy Kipper, his family, Floppy the dog, and his schoolmates, children always read the stories with intimacy.

Stage 1-4 are the daily stories, in Stage 5, Kipper gets a Magic key and the story begins with the colourful fantasy world.

Nadim

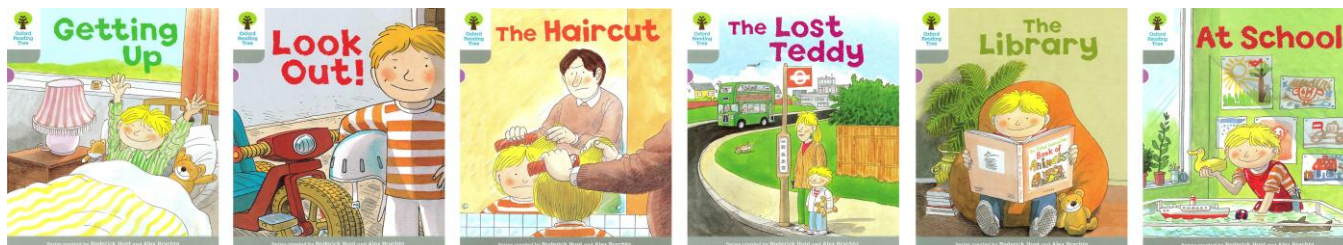
Nadim loves telling jokes and making everyone laugh. Nadim is very good at numbers and loves reading but best of all he loves his computer.

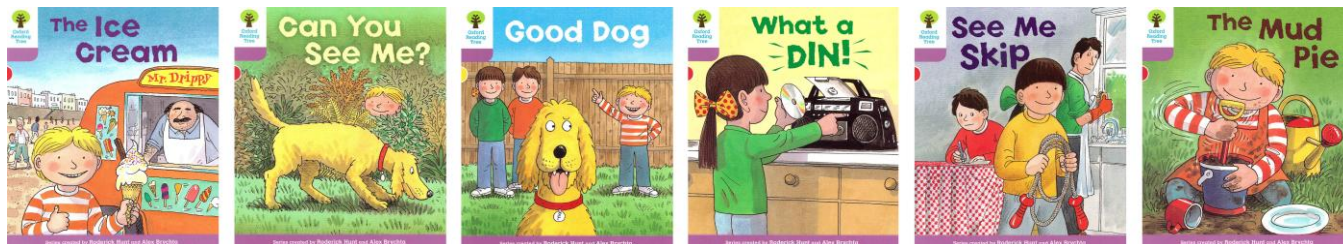


Stage 1+ First Sentences C

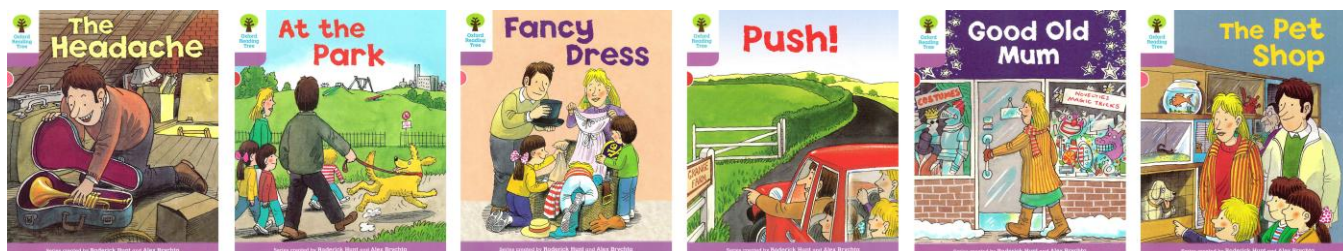

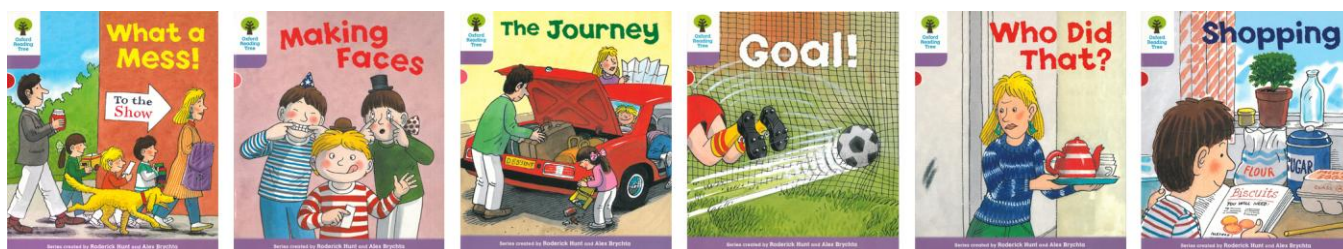
Repetition to practise high frequency words

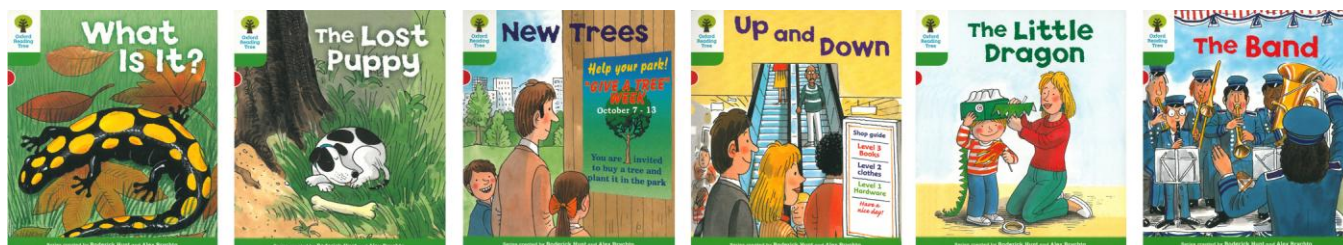

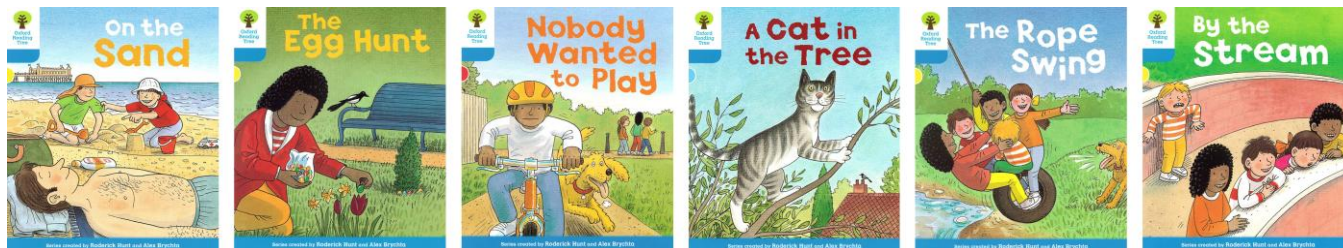


Stage 3 Stories

These slightly longer stories build open pupils' sight vocabulary as well as introducing stories about neighbours Wilf, Wilma, and their mum and dad.

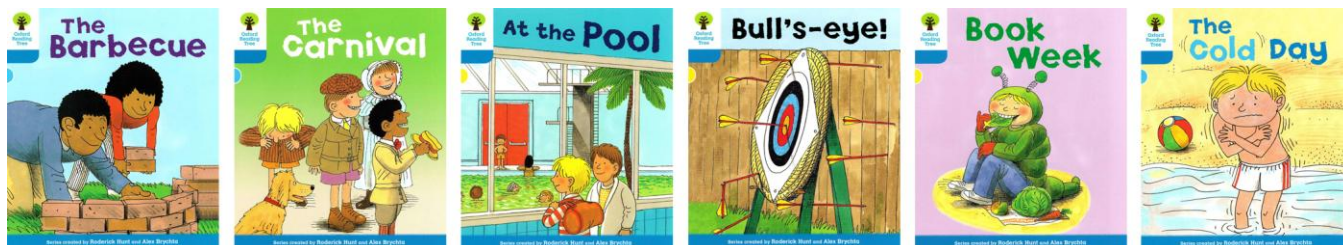

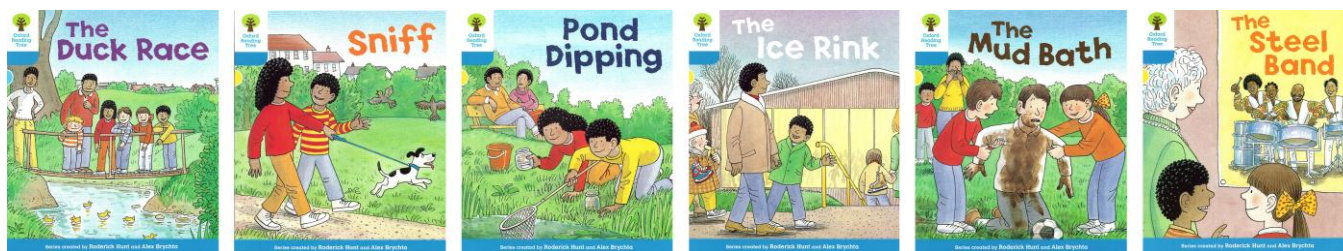
Stage 3 First Sentence

Set the scene for the popular 'Magic Key' stories at Stage 5

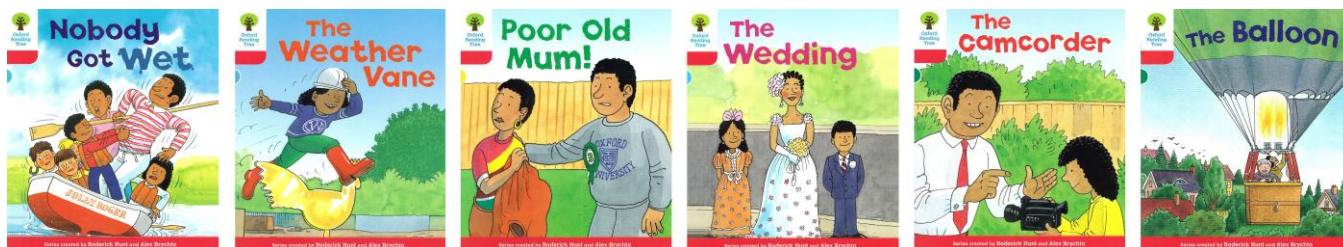
These 24 Stage 4 stories bridge the gap between highly supported reading at stages 1 to 3 and more self supported reading at Stage 5.

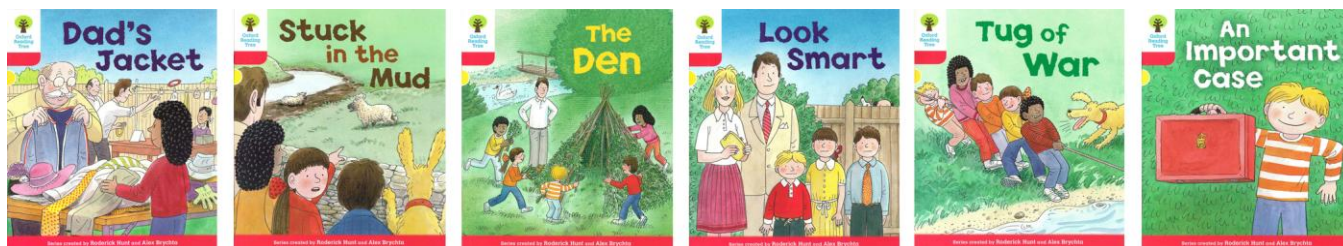

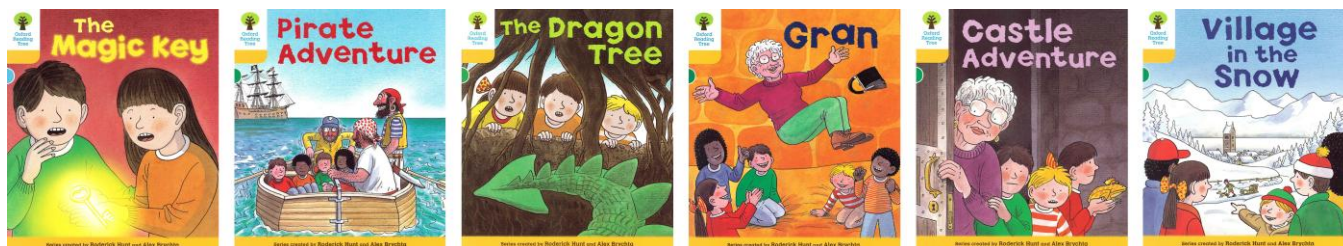


Stage 5 Stories

- These stories develop reading skills and stamina as text increases in amount and complexity

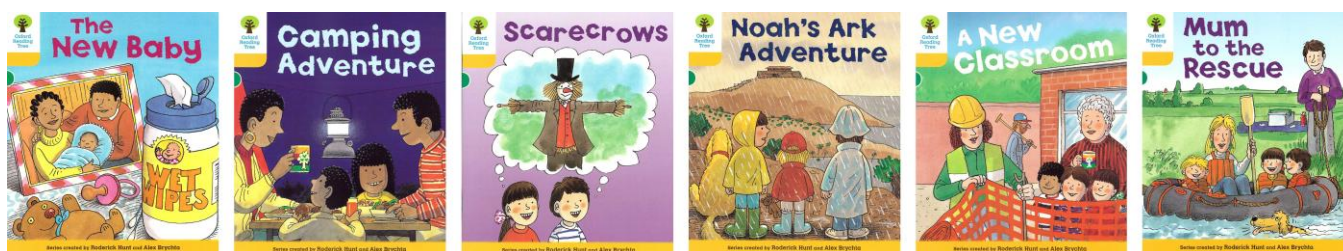

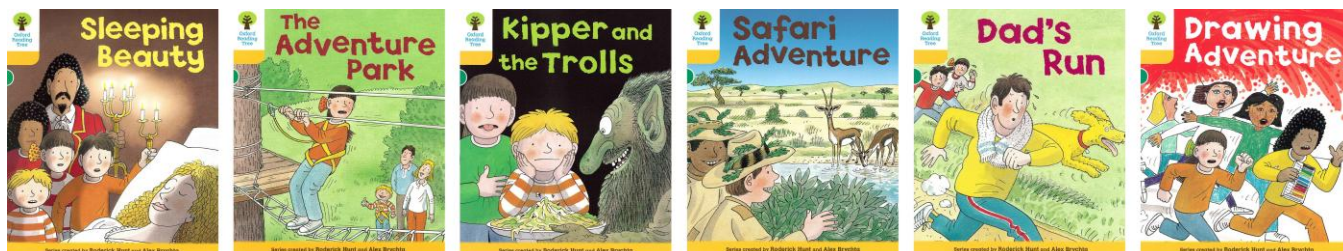

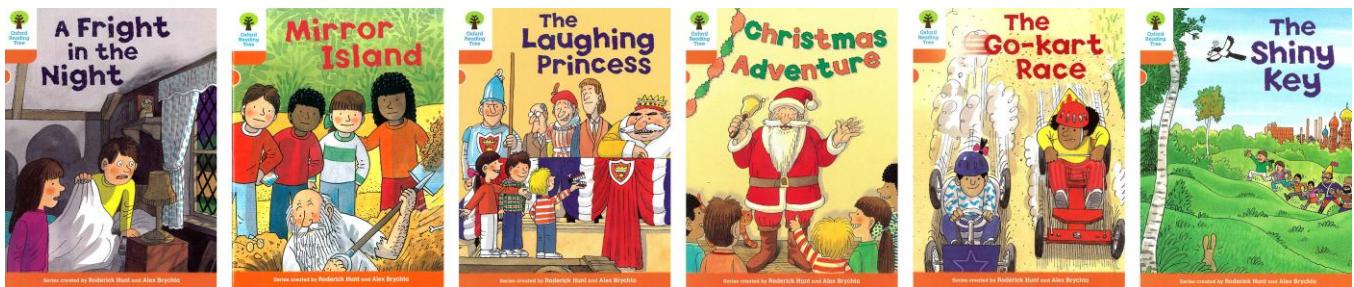
Give children the confidence to practise more complex reading skills

- 12 new stories including two-part adventures to encourage reading stamina

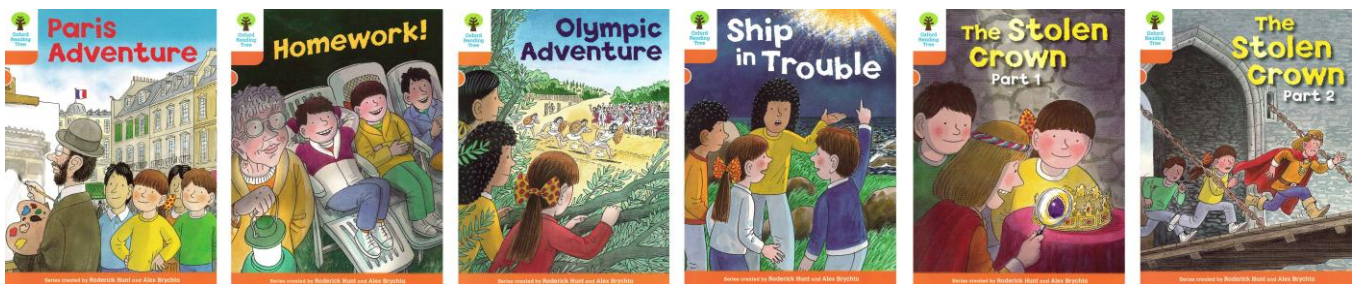

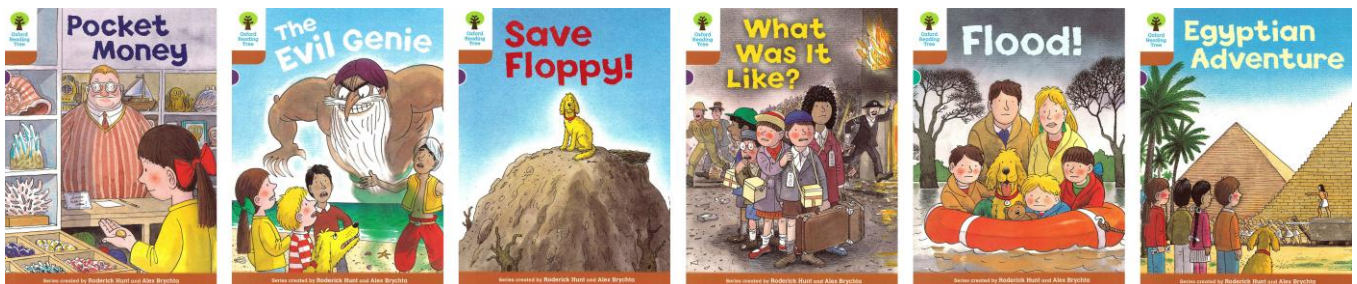
Exciting stories to build reading comprehension and enjoyment

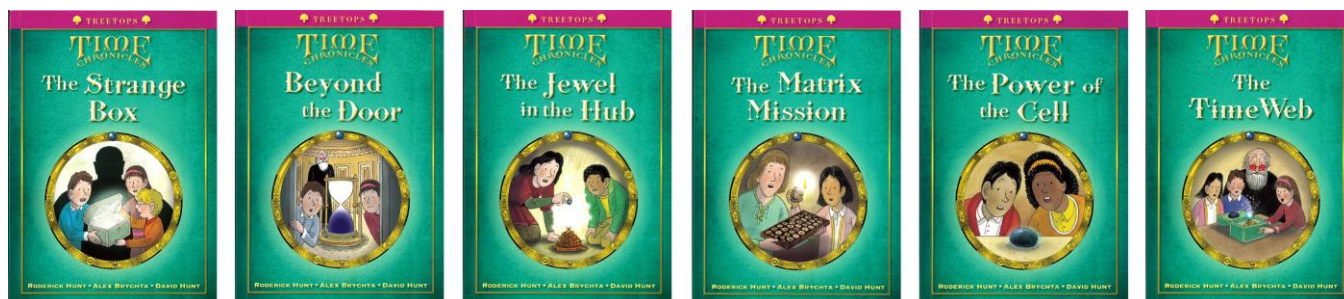

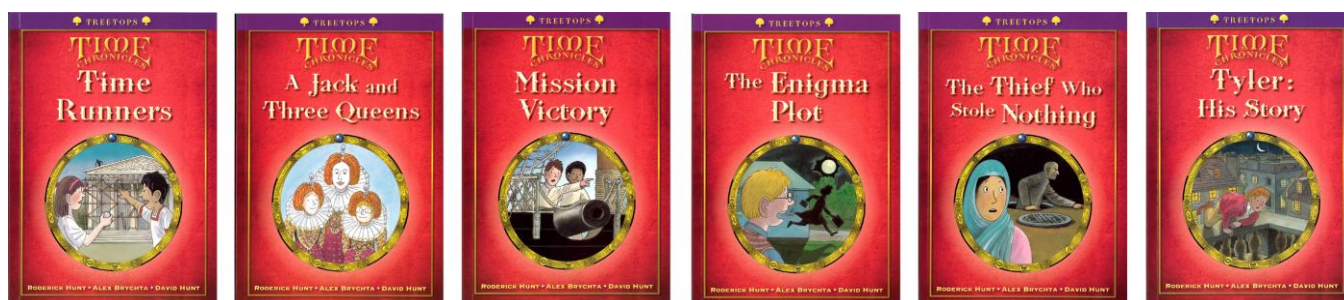

- Questions and a full glossary at the back of each book supports pupil's comprehension of themes

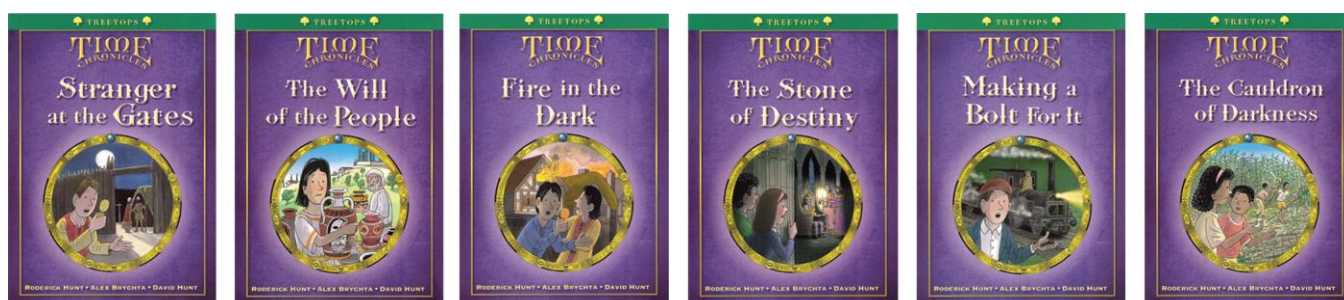
